- Horses must be presented with an approved National or FEI passport.
- 2. All the horses have to be micro-chipped.
- The electronic heart rate monitor and display system shall be used to determine the heart rate of horses as per set protocol.
- At the Pre-ride Inspection please ensure that your horse is sufficiently warmed up before you bring it for inspection. Any horse which will not permit examination or which is dangerous to the examiners shall be eliminated.
- 5. Pre-ride Briefing will be held at the end of the First Inspection.
- 6. Riders must wear hard type riding helmets with chin strap and

- shoes with heels unless they use caged (boxed) or equestrian stirrups.
- Whips, spurs, draw (running) reins/French reins & long reins are not permitted. The horse's head must have freedom of movement.
- Private cars are not permitted in any forestry area. Crew members & drivers please note that any act amounting to intimidation of a competition horse will be severely dealt with. Giving water or assistance from inside a car is forbidden.
- 9. No crewing in the entrances or inside the vet gate. Crew is not

- permitted to wait for the horse at the Time Window.
- Only two persons are permitted with the horse inside gate.
 Any act of deliberate delay in presenting the horse for examination will be severely dealt with.
- Pulse Re-Inspection requires a new Vet-In Time. The exit of the horse from the Vet Inspection Area must be recorded at the "Way Out" window before a new Vet-In Time can be given.
- Recovery Inspections shall be approx. 15 minutes before departure.
- A horse that does not continue after having started in the competition, must be seen by an official Ride Veterinarian.
